Look Ahead is a specialist not-for-profit housing association and provider of tailor-made care, support and accommodation services. We support thousands of people across London and the South East with a diverse range of needs.

As a trauma informed housing provider, we are committed to improving the mental health and wellbeing of young people. We deliver over 20 services for young people and care leavers including a wide range of accommodation-based support, floating and visiting support services.

ABOUT THIS SERVICE

Horn Lane is a spot purchase semi-independent accommodation service for young people located in Ealing. It provides accommodation for up to 14 young people aged 16-25.

Horn Lane has 14 rooms and operates across two buildings. The first building offers high needs support and has three two-bed flats, each with a shared kitchen and bathroom. While the second offers low needs and stepdown support, and has a pair of two-bed flats and a four-bed flat. These flats also have shared bathroom and kitchen facilities. The four-bed flat has a larger kitchen, a toilet, and bathroom.

We focus on creating a safe and homely environment where everyone is individually supported based on their own personal needs. Our teams are trained in trauma informed approaches and understand that mental and physical health difficulties can be a response to a person's life experiences. They aim to prevent re-traumatisation, as they help young people find ways to cope and recover. Our teams are dedicated to supporting young people into employment, education and training and to helping them to identify their goals and aspirations.





SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

- Young people co-produce a range of activities throughout the year, including celebrating diversity and cultural festivities, understanding immigration workshops and group trips.
- The service is regularly audited by Look Ahead's internal quality team and is rated good for care.
- See Think Act: Our person-centred and trauma-informed approach embeds the principles of psychologically informed environments.
- Specialist support for Unaccompanied Asylum seekers.
- Bespoke support planning with access to Look Ahead's life skills programme.
- Communal garden area.
- TV and games console.
- Access to phone translation services (please ask about additional staff languages).
- A short walk to Acton Mainline Elizabeth Line Station and North Acton Tube (Central Line).
